


The Christian Medical Research League

—“The League”, as it is now popularly called was organized in November of 1948 by a group of Christian folks, including several Ministers of the Gospel, for the purpose, among others, of furthering and advancing selected new medical and bio-chemical theories.

To date, the League has chosen to examine into, appraise, experiment with, and participate in the distribution of certain drugs—commonly known as the Koch drugs.

The administrative office of the League is located at 14350 E. Jefferson Avenue, Detroit 15, Michigan. The manufacturing laboratory of the League is also located at this address. The size of the present laboratory and office facilities of the League have recently proven inadequate and, as this is written, plans are being prepared for a new and completely modern manufacturing laboratory and administrative headquarters. There is

also now being established an experimental and research laboratory in the City of Midland, Michigan—the home of the great Dow Chemical Company.

The League is a non-profit Michigan corporation. Membership dues and operating profits must be utilized solely and exclusively for charitable purposes of a religious or medical nature. The League is comprised of various types of membership, each of which is described in the Application for Membership.

The members of the League meet from time to time but not less frequently than once a year. The Annual Meeting is in September. Trustees are elected at this meeting. There are nine members on the Board of Trustees, of whom three are elected each year for a three year term. The Executive Committee of the League, consisting of three members of the Board of Trustees, carry most of the burden of general management and policy making.

All officers and members of the Board of Trustees—even the President, who acts as the chief executive officer and necessarily devotes most of his time to its affairs—serve the League without any compensation whatever.
