UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

William Koch Takes Highest Stand In Examination To Which Students from 25 High Schools Competed

William Koch, a Detroit boy, who has been taking a post-graduate course at the Eastern High School, won the six years' scholarship offered by the Chicago University in a competitive examination of students from 25 high schools of the country. Young Koch is about 19 years of age and is a graduate from the Field school. He finished his course in the Eastern High last January, his postgraduate course followed. During his vacations and Saturdays he assisted at the store on Townsend and St. Paul Aves, belonging to his mother, with whom he lives. Should the work of young Koch prove satisfactory in the "Rockefeller college" he will have an opportunity to become a member of the faculty at the completion of his studies there, but at present his ambition is to become a physician.
