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Dr. Koch

Saint or Charlatan

WHETHER the Federal Trade Commission can sustain a permanent injunction restraining Dr. William F. Koch, M.D., Ph.D., of Detroit, from advertising the chemical catalyst he is using in the treatment of cancer, will be determined during scheduled hearings. Dr. Koch was tried in Federal Court last year for mislabelling his product. The trial began in January, 1943, and continued until the latter part of May. Although it was the *longest and most expensive medical case in American Court history*, according to newspaper reports in Detroit, little publicity was released about it outside the local circulation area. The Government failed to convict. Case records presented and substantiated at the trial revealed sixty-nine different cases "cured" or "greatly improved" by Dr. Koch's remedies. This was reported in *The Journal of the American Medical Association* which, according to its own editorial *admissions*, had been prodding the Government for many years to look into the affairs of the Koch Laboratories.

That the remedy developed by Dr. Koch has "cured" many different types of cancer, and also restored to health victims of other serious diseases, is a matter of court record. Witnesses at his trial included well-known and respected members of the medical profession, from Canada and South America, as well as the United States. Chemically and theoretically, Dr. Koch's remedy has been proven time and time again, and experience has demonstrated that it does not harm patients, as is too often the case with sulfa drugs.

Dr. Koch's troubles began more than twenty years ago, when he offered his remedy to his profession. The scientific stuffed-shirts demanded that he surrender his formula before they would clinically test it. This he obstinately refused to do. He believed that it would be subjected to unfair trial—and this conclusion was based upon the utter skepticism with which his announcement was received by his profession, even though at that time Dr. Koch was Professor of Physiology at the Detroit College of Medicine, and had taught previously at the University of Michigan. There is no doubt that he was looked upon as a youthful



intruder into the sanctum sanctorum of the big wigs of modern medicine.

FINALLY, however, a clinical test was arranged at the Herman Keifer Hospital, Detroit. Incurable and inoperable cases of cancer were selected and placed under the care of Dr. Koch. As some of these began to show improvement, the great, humanitarian profession of medicine turned green, and literally kicked the cases out of the hospital. A number of the patients got well in spite of this expulsion and served for years as a check-rein on organized and envious efforts to put Dr. Koch out of circulation.

In 1934, Dr. Koch was invited to participate in clinical tests of his remedy at Louvain University in Belgium. He spent six months there, and the catalyst was tried on cancer, African Sleeping Sickness, Leprosy and other conditions with startling results. Its value was authenticated. The formula was given to leading research scientists in Belgium, Germany and other European countries. Evidence shows that the remedy has been used since 1936 by the German Army.

Obviously, the forces back of the persecution of Dr. Koch have their origin in the munificent offices of organized pharmacy and orthodox medicine—and these are well entrenched in government bureaucracies, such as the well-financed Federal Food and Drug Department.

The struggles of this humble, betrayed scientist form a sinister pattern of government authority being utilized to suppress a remedy of universal benefit. Radium, X-ray and surgery thrive in the cancer racket. The specialists grow rich. And it is the exponents of these methods who turn up their pseudo-scientific noses at Dr. Koch. It is

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they who urge Uncle Sam to liquidate him and his catalyst by sending him to the penitentiary.

Somewhere near a million cancer victims may hope to Heaven that the powerful Federal Trade Commission has, among its officials, someone with sufficient courage to strike the shackles from this man.

Not since the advent of Zola's "J' Accuse" has the persecution of any man so justified public wrath against concentrated tyranny.
