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An Open Letter...

The ultimate goal of our association is the elimination of cancer as a problem for all mankind.

We are convinced that many of the answers to the complex cancer problem now exist, but are not generally accepted. Other answers will be obtained by the application and refinement of existing knowledge. We expect further knowledge to come largely through independent thinking, much as it has in the past.

Our secondary goals are to contribute to the elimination of cancer through attention to the areas of:

Another of our goals is for the many worthy independent research groups and schools of thinking, including ourselves, to work together harmoniously toward the ultimate goal of cancer elimination. Many individuals and groups often have had to fight against tremendous odds for their very survival. In their perhaps justifiably emotional state it is sometimes difficult for these people to recognize that many other independent groups and people not holding views identical to theirs are really friends in the common fight against cancer. If these emotions can be restrained, the ultimate winner is the cancer victim.

Perhaps it seems that acceptance of these goals is a bold and vast undertaking for a new organization such as ours. However, the urgent need has been a great stimulus to many of us. Although there is a long way to go, it is surprising to consider what has been accomplished toward our goals in just over three years through the effort and assistance of many dedicated people.

Indicative of our progress has been the increase in conference attendance — from 60 in our founder's home in 1964, to 500 in the El Cortez Hotel in San Diego in 1965, to 1200 in the Ambassador Hotel in Los Angeles in 1966. We expect about 2,000 in 1967 at the Ambassador. Never before has any forum presented the thinking of so many independent researchers to so many physicians and laymen.

Many thousands of people have received information through our association and its members. Undoubtedly our single most effective communication is the Cancer News Journal, donated each month to our association, dedicated researchers, cancer patients, and physicians.

Through the contributions and efforts of many members and friends we have been able to assist a research clinic in Mexico. In this clinic hundreds of cancer patients have obtained satisfaction and relief. This research clinic is working toward improvements in therapy and diagnosis.

Through other contributions our association has been able to assist a dedicated Los Angeles physician and his cancer patients in defending their rights in court. Other independent researchers and patients also deserve our assistance as we are able to provide it.

Through the support of existing research facilities and clinics and through the establishment of new research centers we expect to assist in relieving the cancer problem considerably more than we have been able to in the past.

Through the formation of more chapters, reading rooms, and information centers, and through publicity we expect to provide information, education, hope, and motivation to hundreds of thousands of cancer victims and their friends.

We shall continue to advocate and support the rights of physicians, researchers, and cancer victims, particularly terminal cancer victims. We believe the terminal cancer patient and his physician have the right to use any non-toxic therapy they agree upon, particularly when the patient is otherwise hopeless.

We realize that it is necessary to have efficient, responsible administration so we can achieve our goals and obtain the confidence and trust required to support our programs.

Of course, funding is essential to pursue all of our goals that will contribute to the ultimate elimination of cancer. We encourage each of our members and friends to contribute according to his ability. Since the available funding is largely dependent upon the size of our membership, we strongly encourage everyone to solicit as many new memberships as possible.

Together we can accomplish our goals.

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A note about Koch and his great book, THE SURVIVAL FACTOR IN NEOPLASTIC AND VIRAL DISEASES (CNJ, 7/67)

Throughout the history of science every advancement had its periods of gestation and its birth pains. So it was with Galileo, Lister, Morgan, Pasteur and most notably to us, the contribution of Gomberg's free radical chemistry, first opposed by orthodox chemistry and held from 1900 until ten years ago in a lethargy with little interest except by a few gas-phase kineticists and the developers of the Plastic Industry. It was in this period that Dr. Koch developed his findings of the function of the parathyroid glands and then his work on Natural Immunity, always bitterly opposed, even though offered in the terminology of the day and as wide from Free Radical Chemistry as possible until of late, when a sudden sweep of interest took biochemists out of their doldrums and today all biochemistry is being interpreted on Free Radical principles world-wide in all leading institutions so far as its new and most wonderful chemistry has progressed.

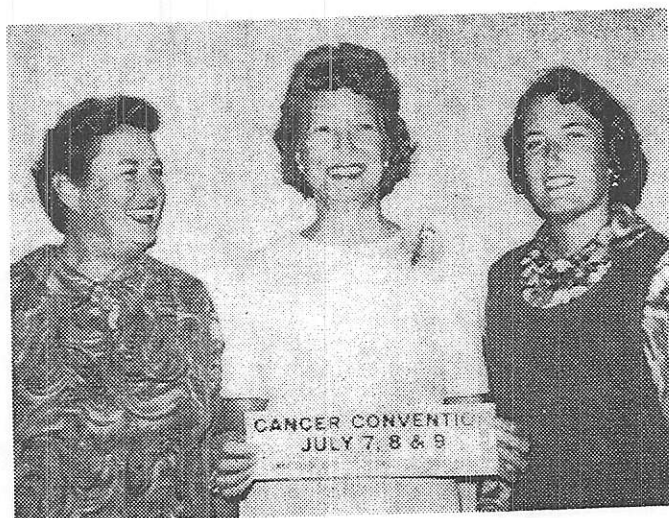
To tell the history of Koch's work and its opposition and suppression is not in our present program. A few World Leaders in Free Radical development and industry will give an idea of the progressive phase of his work. For example, Dr. Willard Dow, life time President of the Vast Dow Chemical Industries, and an appreciator of Koch's contribution on the solution of the Cancer Problem stated in 1946, "So far as I am personally concerned I consider him one of the outstanding Scientists in the Medical Profession, and he is so far ahead of the thinking of his Profession that he is naturally ridiculed somewhat." "As I understand it, his treatment in the virus form of cancer will run anywhere from 40 to 60 percent cure." This estimate, after mature investigation, is seconded by Dr. William Hale, long time Director of the Scientific Research of Dow Chemical Company, and also leader in the Free Radical Chemical development, who stated to a leading American Statesman, "Today Koch's work is not understood,

but in years to come, when the history of medicine is again written, Koch's name will stand ahead of that of Pasteur."

So it is that today we have in Koch's work the interpretation of the cancer and virus problems, and with it a whole new concept of pathogenesis in all diseases with their reversals as well on the basis of Free Radical Chemistry. The least common denominator is offered. Fifty years of proofs and development are condensed in the book, "THE SURVIVAL FACTOR IN NEOPLASTIC AND VIRAL DISEASES". The Free Radical makes the understanding of the Natural Immunity simple and comprehensive. Based on the phenomena of the Free Radical and the double bond, as well as the azomethine condensation the whole pathology and a new appreciation of pathogenesis from its first vanguards to its autopsy findings is presented and also their reversals so long as life lasts in the body. The reversals are demonstrated as permanent and complete, and so proven beyond contradiction factually in the Federal Courts. What could not be opposed in open court and was firmly demonstrated as fact, the Food and Drug Administration and Federal Trade Commission lied about openly in their attempts to hold smug orthodoxy in the profit saddle entirely disregarding the progress of medicine and the earnest desire of the profession to cure their cases in line with their Hypocratic oath.

The German translation lead the way immediately and the first edition was sold out at the first announcement (within ninety days) at Christmas, 1966, with an interest characteristically progressive. The enthusiasm in America was held in restraint among those who heard about it, until now when all may enjoy its prior prestige and benefits.
